Are you unemployed? Do you need training/certification and related work experience to find employment? Are you interested in working as a Building Service Worker?

If 'yes', VCC's Building Service Worker Plus (BSWP) Training Program may be able to help you with your training/work experience needs.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Building Service Worker (BSW) Plus, a 12-week full-time Project Based Training (PBT) program is designed to serve 16 eligible participants through classroom training and hands on work experience and provide them with the skills/certifications needed to secure employment. Upon completion, participants will receive VCC's Award of Achievement and three industry certifications; WHMIS, FoodSafe and WorldHost Fundamentals. Program graduates will have the qualifications required to secure employment as janitors, caretakers, custodians, building service workers, housekeepers or general helpers.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

You may be eligible if you are:

- Unemployed and non EI eligible, no EI claims in the past three years and no maternity/paternity EI claims in the past five years
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Living in British Columbia
- Not a student (i.e. enrolled in high school or enrolled in post-secondary training)
- Not actively participating in another provincially or federally funded labour market program at the time of training
- Experiencing difficulties securing employment due to lack of skills training

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have:

Besides fulfilling the PBT eligibility requirements, applicants must have:

- English (CLB level 6 or above)
- Able to commit to a full-time program for 12 weeks
- Physically fit to work in a cleaning environment (e.g. no chemical allergies)
- No criminal record
