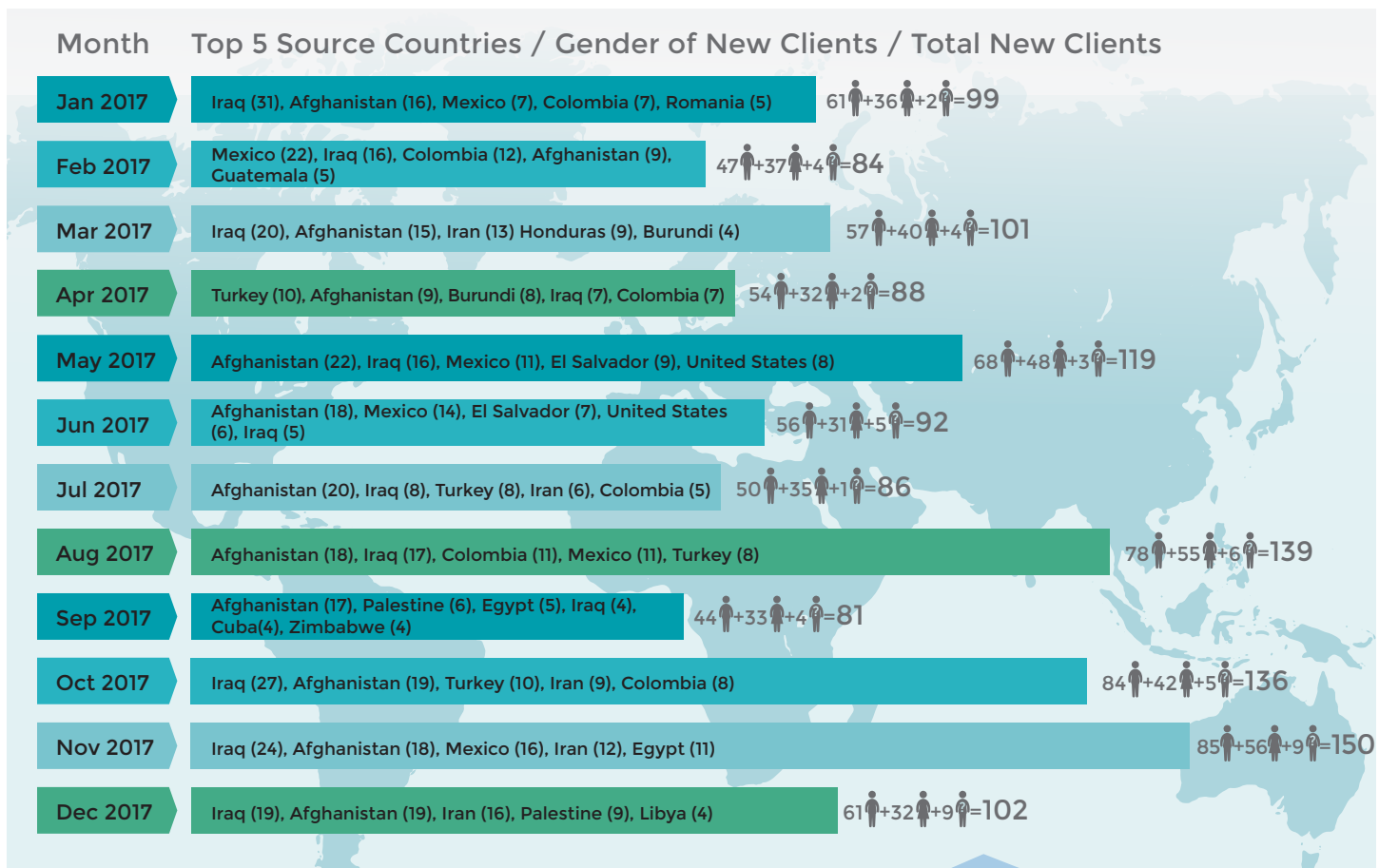

Monthly Stats of New Refugee Claimant Clients: 2017*



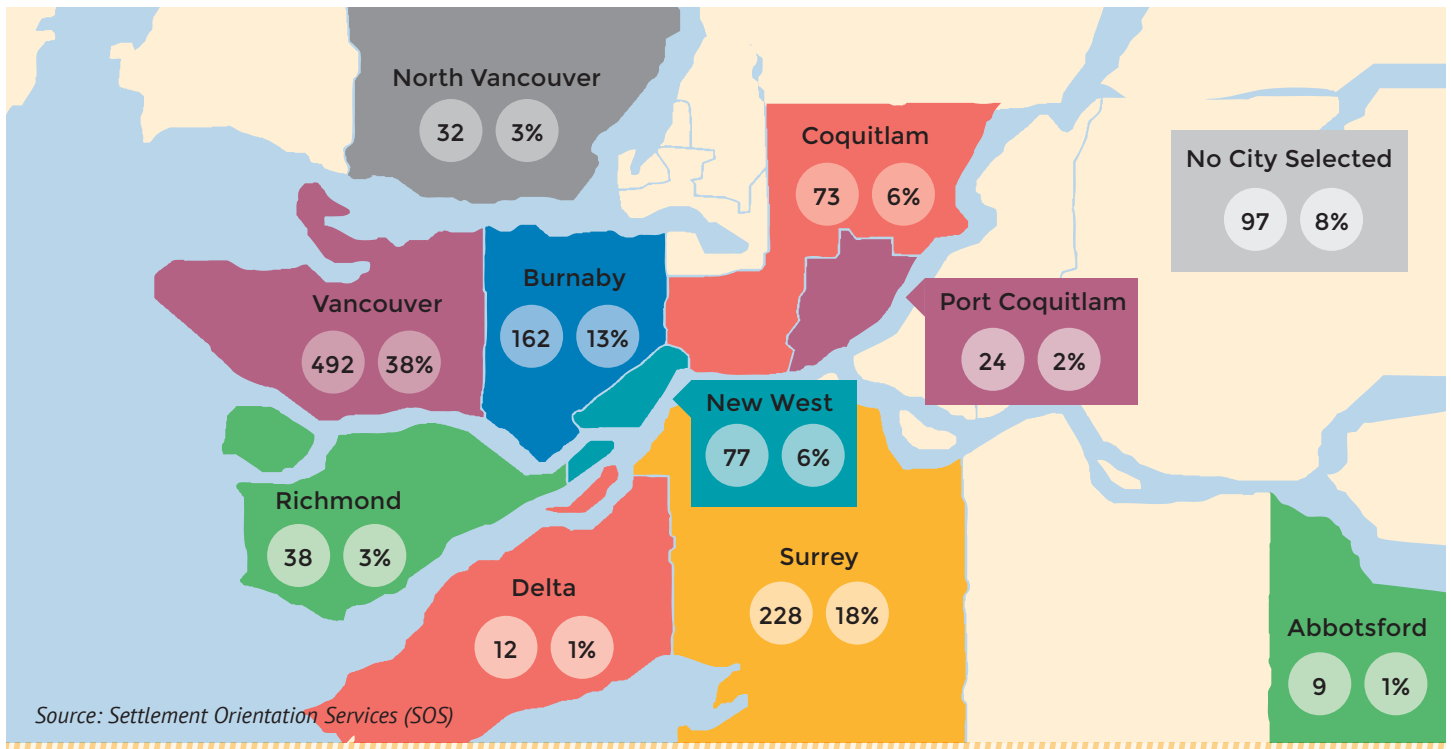
Jan 1, 2017-Dec 31, 2017: **1277** new refugee claimants / **1914** total clients served

Trends and Observations

74% OF OUR CLIENTS were from the 3 top languages: Spanish (26%), Arabic (25%), Farsi/Dari (23%);



IN 2017 WE SAW a small wave of refugee claimants from Turkey (47 individuals arriving);



AN ESTIMATED NINETY PERCENT (90%) of refugee claimants walk across the US border at the Peace Arch Park;
