The family of **Pritam Singh & Beant Kaur Benning** have set up this bursary to help newcomers to Canada, just as they helped their family set up roots. Pritam and Beant moved

from Punjab, India to London, England in the early 1960s and then to Vancouver, Canada in the early 1980s. They moved across two continents, experienced cultural barriers and persevered to give their children and future generations of their family better lives. Their family – which includes seven children and 19 grandchildren – have created this bursary to honour their memory and help newcomers in their journeys through post-secondary education.

BURSARY APPLICANTS

Apply anytime before the deadline.

Deadline is JUNE 30

Please note that the Bursary is not available to employees of ISSofBC.

THE ELIGIBLE STUDENT...

(Please check all boxes that apply to you)

- Has a financial need for assistance with tuition;
- Is a current or former client, student or volunteer of ISSofBC;
- Is 19 years or over;
- Is a newcomer to Canada within three years of the deadline;
- Is legally entitled to attend school in Canada;
- Needs this program to return to former occupation or to attain career goals;
- Has applied for a course of studies appropriate to that individual's career planning. The studies may be full-time or part-time;
- Meets the English level required for the course.

PLEASE SUBMIT A BRIEF LETTER & INCLUDE:

- Support of your eligibility as listed prior;
- Description of your hopes for your new life in Canada, and future career plans;
- How this course will enhance your goals; and
- Letter of acceptance from your accredited post-secondary institution.

Bursary payment is contingent upon acceptance in the course, and is payable directly to the Training Institute. Funds must be used before September of the following year.

REVIEW COMMITTEE

Applications will be reviewed by the Bursary Committee, which is appointed by the ISSofBC Board of Directors.

PRESENTATION

The winning applicant will be presented with a Bursary Certificate (up to \$1,000 value) at the Annual General Meeting in September.
