





## LOOKING AHEAD

In April 2022, **ISSofBC** launched the **Surrey Resettlement Assistance Team**, increasing our ability to resettle Government Assisted Refugees (**GAR**) in Metro Vancouver. We anticipate continued high arrivals throughout the next quarter until the end of 2022, including both Afghan and non-Afghan **GAR**s.
