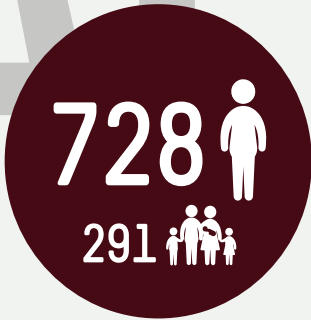

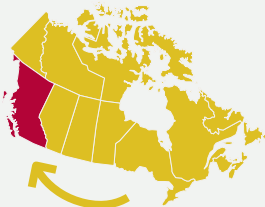

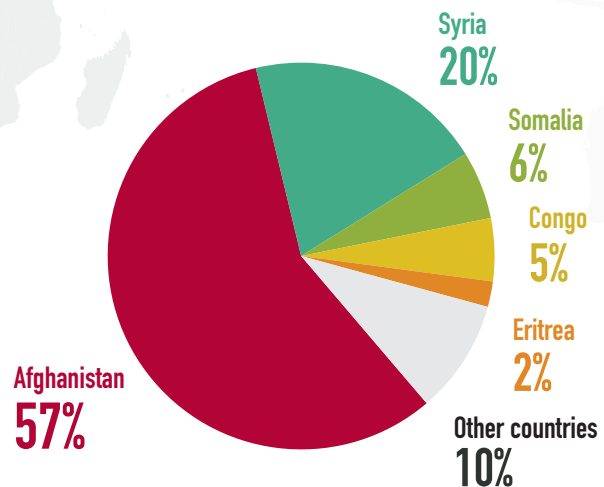

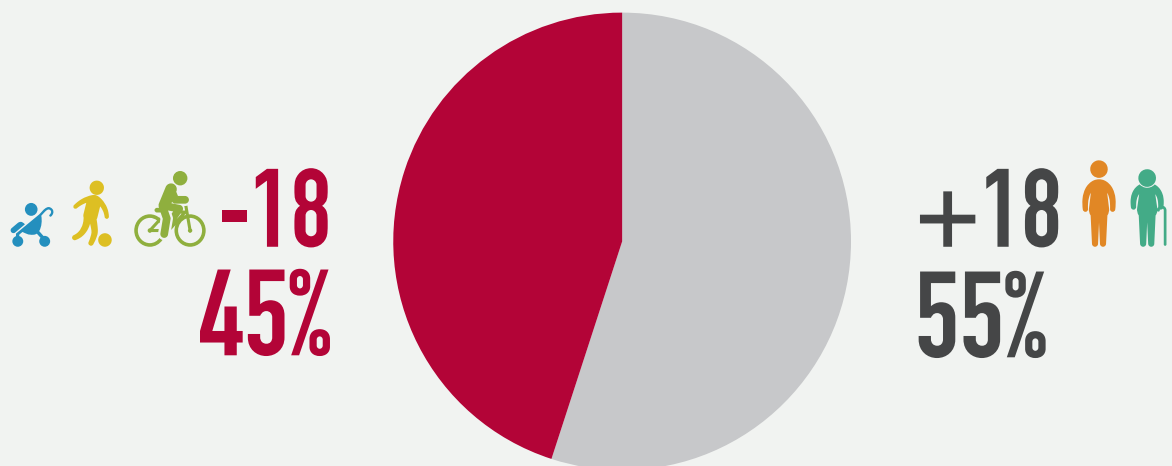

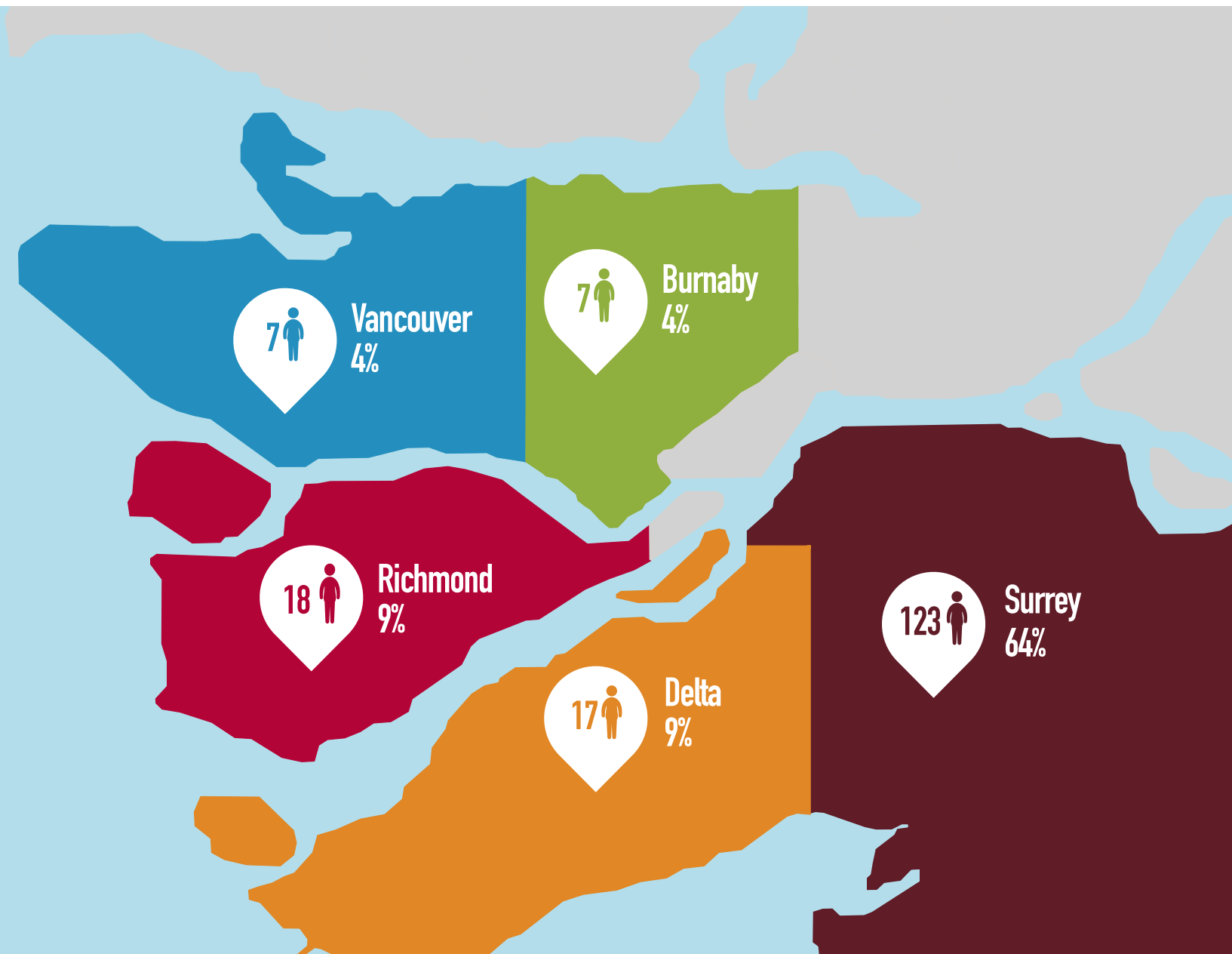

# AGE BREAKDOWN



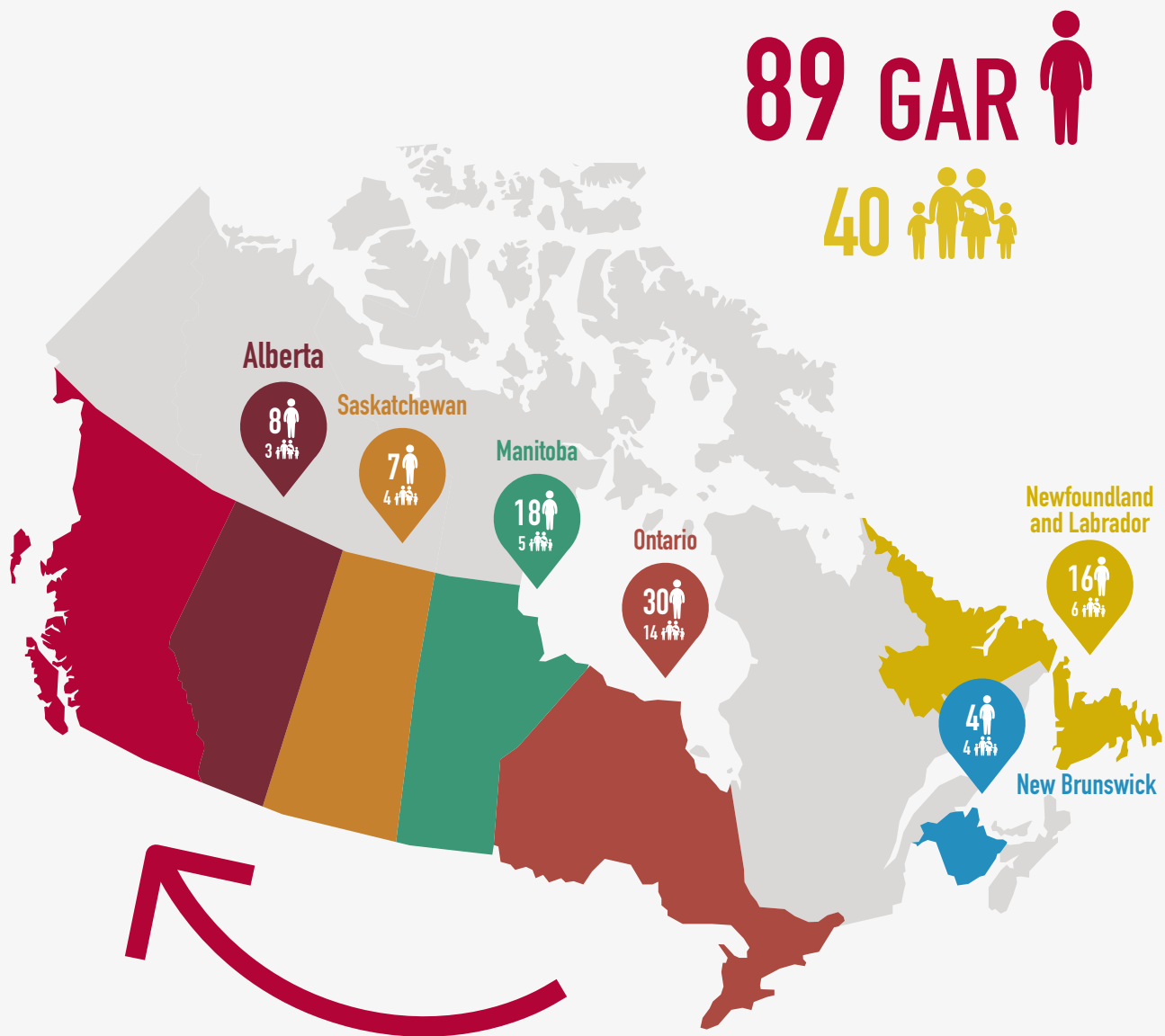
# TOP 5 DESTINATIONS BY MUNICIPALITY



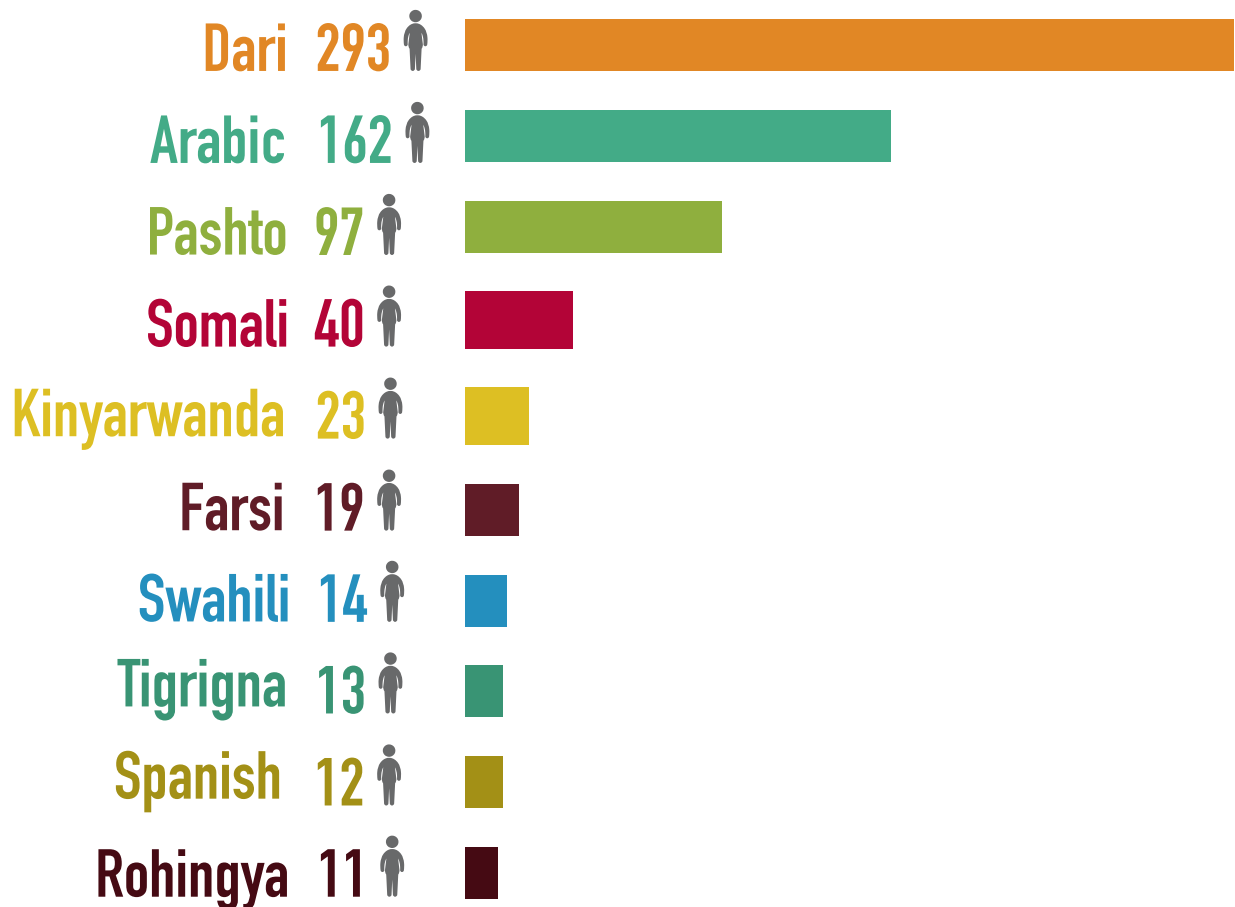
