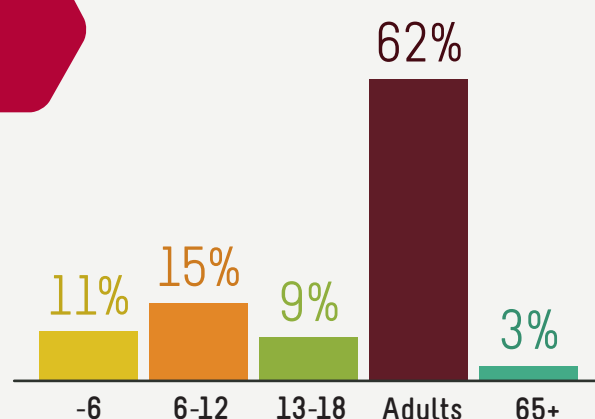
Top 5 source countries



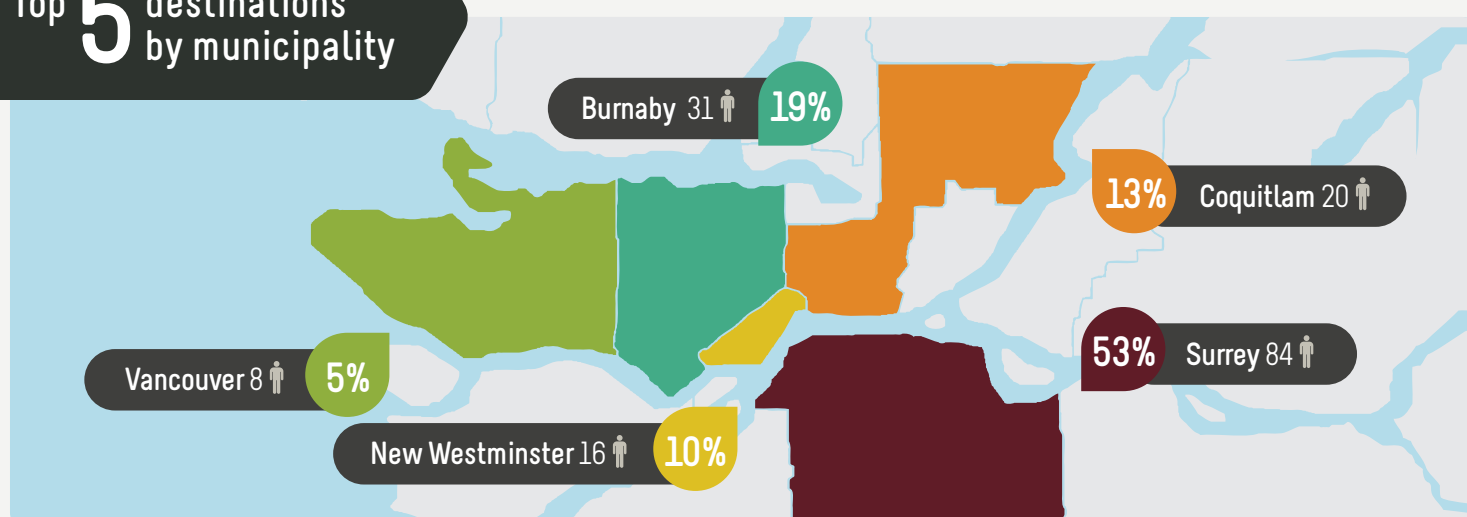
Population ages
