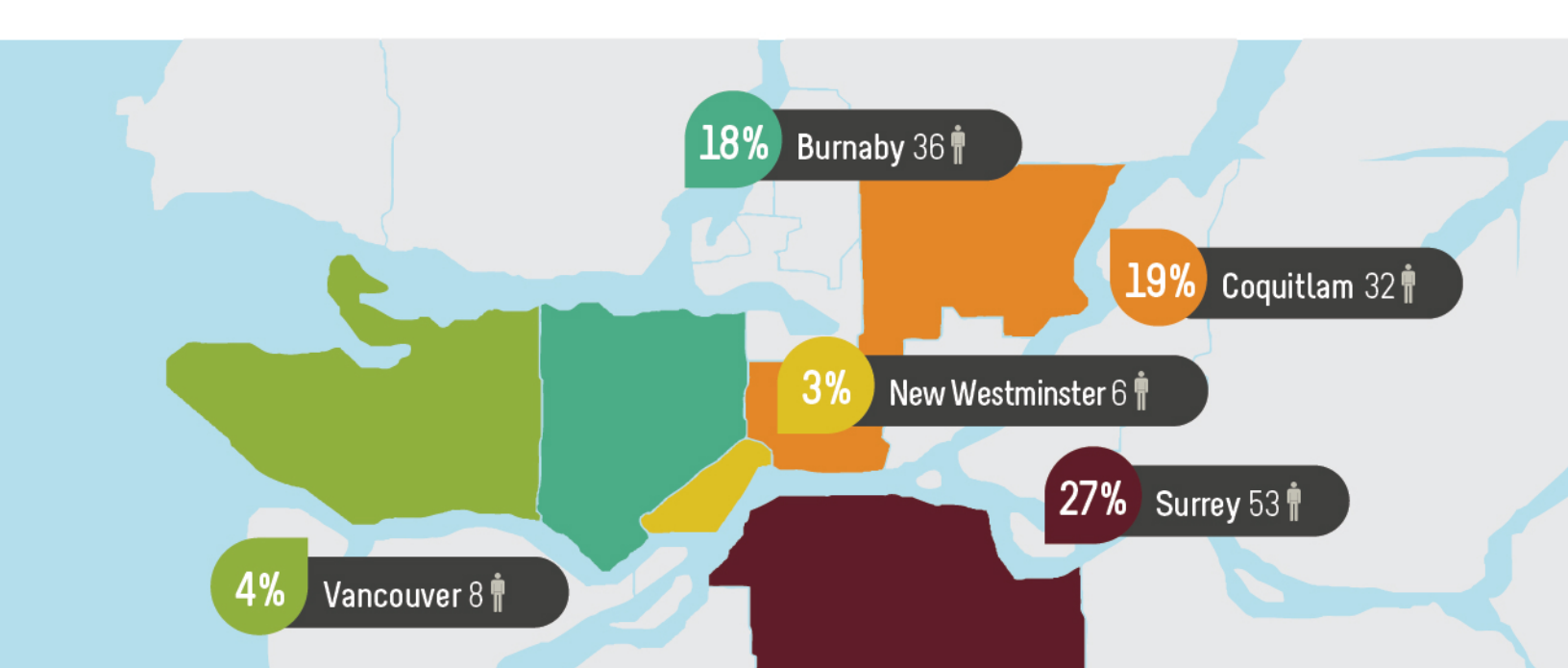

## Age breakdown

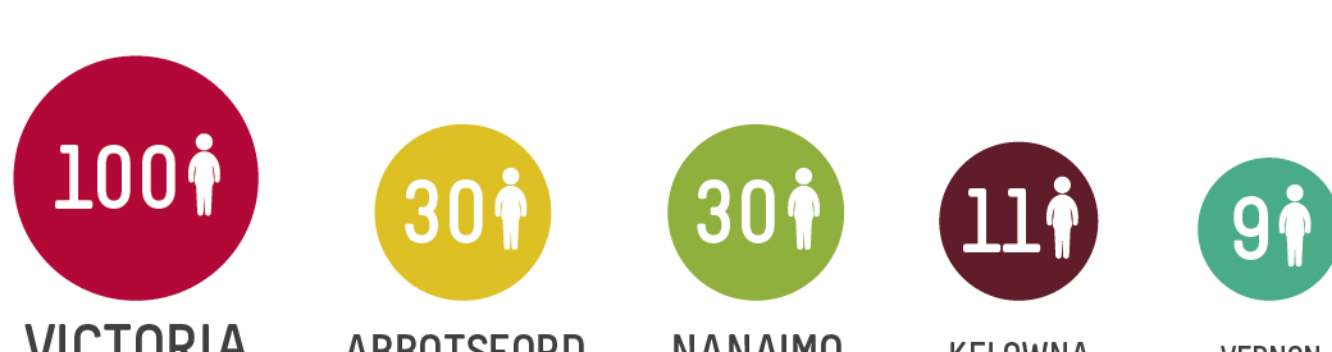


## Top 5 destinations by municipality



» **IRCC** has extended temporary service provider arrangements that enable Government Assisted Refugees to be settled in communities across British Columbia until June 2018. The Inter-Cultural Association of Victoria (ICA) will continue as a **RAP** Contribution Agreement holder, and the **ISSofBC**-led hub and spoke model will see **GARs** settling directly in Abbotsford, Nanaimo, Kelowna and Vernon;

» **IRCC** has finalized 2017 **GAR** targets for British Columbia. Vancouver is anticipated to welcome 720 Government Assisted Refugees in 2017. An additional 180 **GARs** will be destined to smaller centres, including:
