


# Top source countries



# Age breakdown




# Top 5 destinations by municipality

# Looking ahead

- » BC **GAR** target will likely increase by 120 as a result of the federal budget announcement to increase Canada's **GAR** target by 1,000 places earmarked for women and girls
- » Starting April 1, the number of destination sites will be dropped to three - **Metro Vancouver** and **Kelowna** through **ISSofBC** and **Victoria** led by **ICA**
- » Over 135 **GARs** are currently scheduled to arrive within the next three months from over **10 different source countries**
- » While **Syria** (51 individuals) will continue to represent the largest single source country of **GARs**, **45%** (or 62 individuals) of current projected arrivals will come from the African continent mainly from **Democratic Republic of the Congo**, **Eritrea** and **Somalia**
