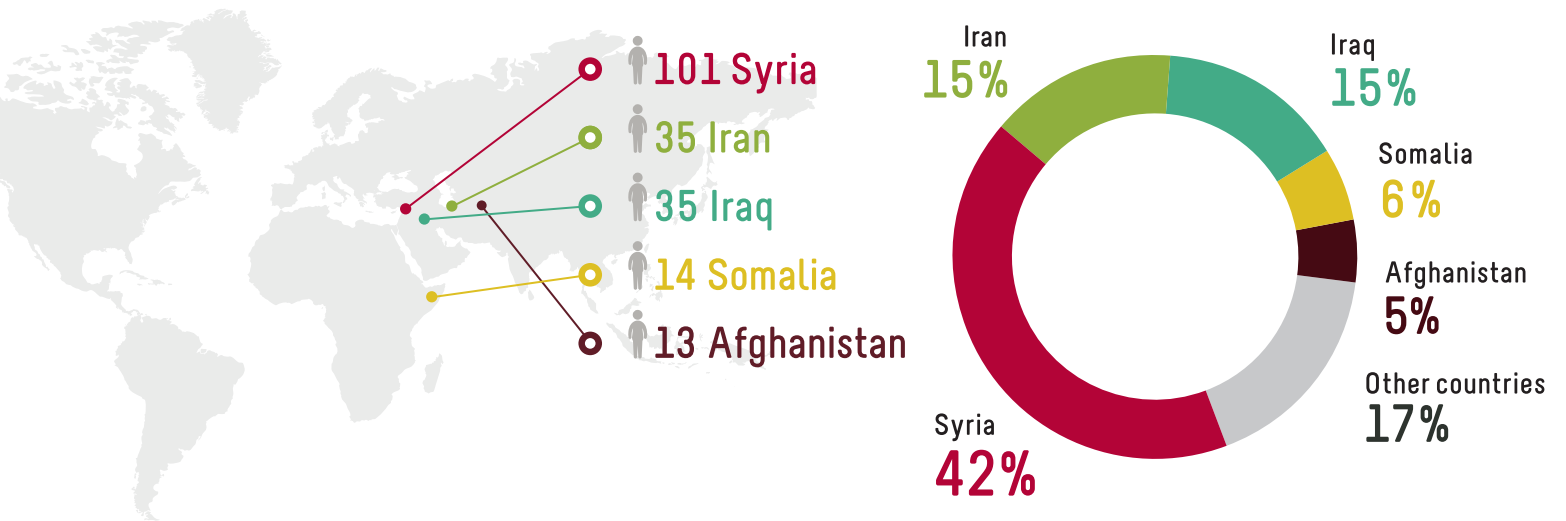

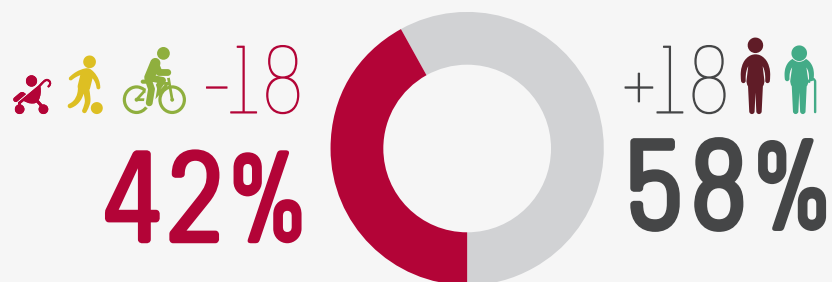
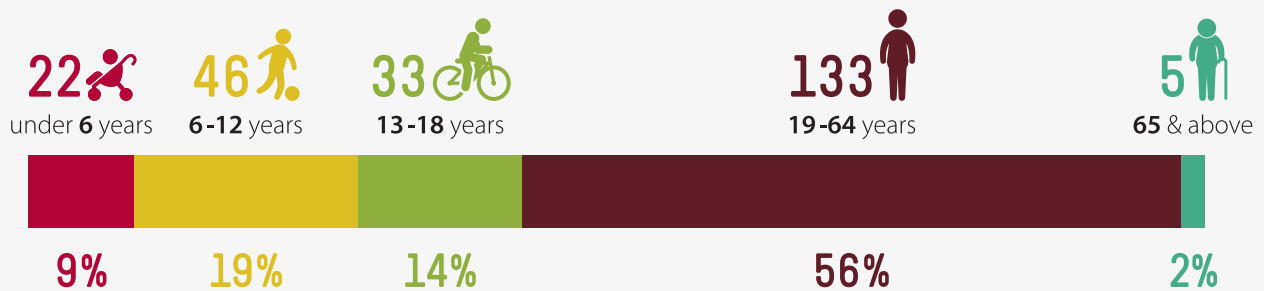

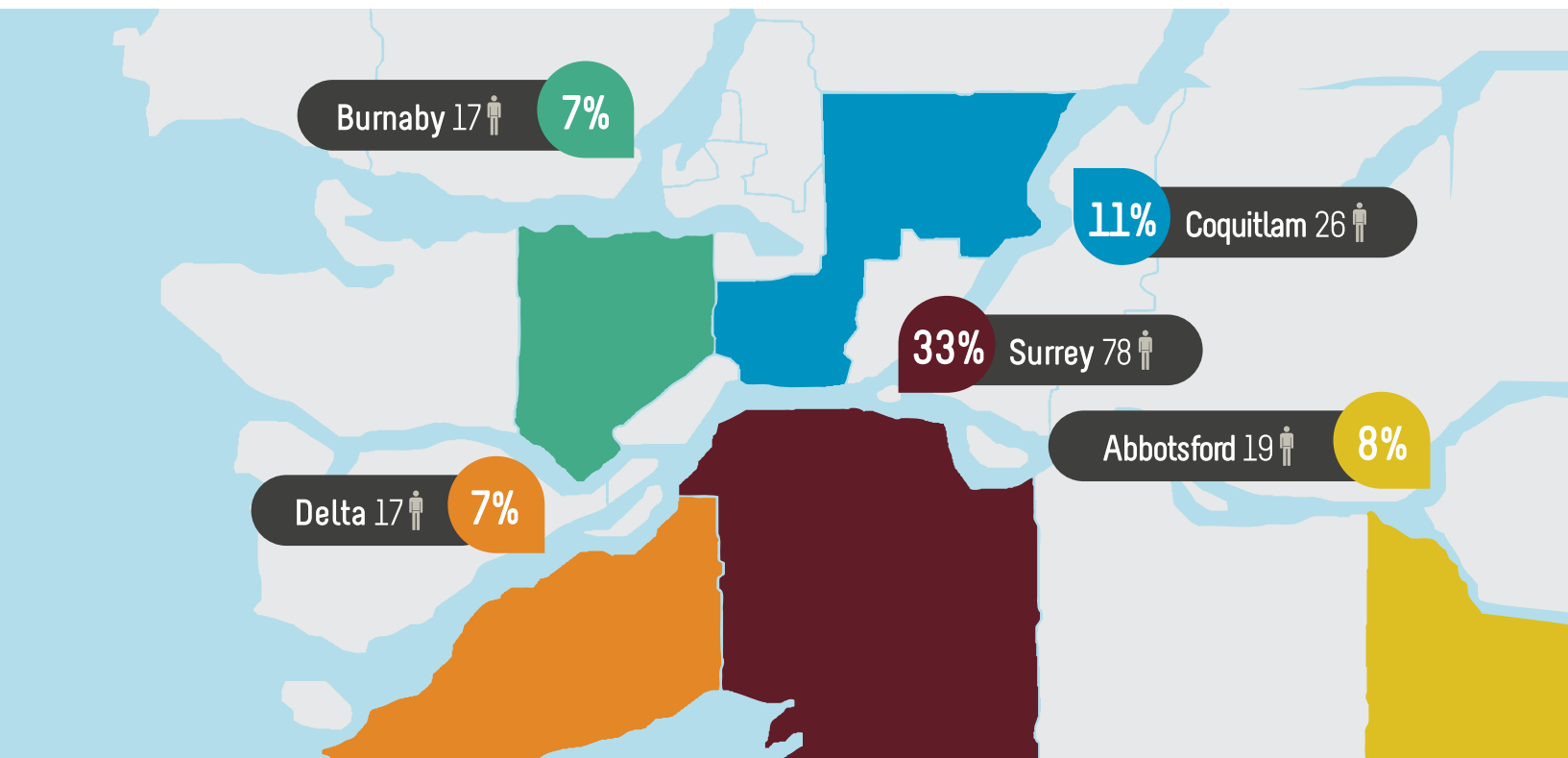
Top 5 source countries

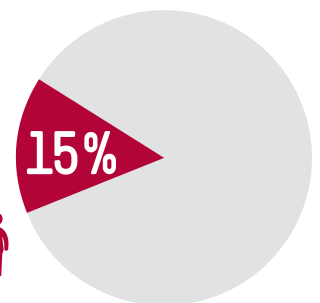
